

## **PLEASE READ IMPORTANT**

Dear Allotment Holders,

The Suffolk Pest Control Company Ltd has been employed by Thetford Town Council to help manage the rat issues at Mundford Road Allotments. Our goal is to eradicate all rats and maintain a rat free environment for you to tend to your allotments in.

To achieve this goal we will be deploying tamper resistant rodent bait stations across the site. We may need to place some in your allotment space. If so, please do not touch or move these boxes as it is important that they remain where our technicians place them and that we can return to inspect them. A number of the boxes have tracking devices built in.

How you can help?

Please allow us good access, do not let your allotment become a safe zone for rats to re-populate your neighbours from.

Rats like to nest under cover, this is often sheds, piles of wood or rubbish or even overgrowth. By keeping your allotment neat and tidy we will limit nest site opportunities.

Compost bins are a source of food and a warm place to nest in winter. Try placing compost bins on top of suitable wire mesh or on a concrete slab base.

Use sealable containers to keep seed and bulbs safe.

Only give your chickens what they need to eat each day, collect up anything they do not eat. Limiting rat access to your chickens feed will deny them an alternative food source to our products.

Please note that our technicians have a large area to cover and limited time to do so, they may not have the time to talk with you.
